Dear .US Registrar,

On February 2, 2005, we submitted to you a copy of a letter from the United States Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration ("NTIA") requiring that you and your partners/resellers cease offering proxy or anonymous domain name services by no later than February 16, 2005. It has come to our attention that you or your resellers are still offering a proxy or anonymous domain name service as of the date of this letter.

We consider the offering of such services to be a violation of your obligations under both the usTLD Registrar Accreditation and the usTLD Administrator-Registrar Agreements ("Agreements"). As such, we are hereby formally notifying you of your breach. In accordance with the Agreements, you will have fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter to cure your violation. We believe that the only way to cure such a breach is to cease offering the proxy services.

We are in receipt of your letter dated February 16<sup>th</sup> confirming your intent to come into compliance with the policy against proxy domain name registrations services. The letter does not set forth the date by which you will be in compliance with that policy.

If you are unable or unwilling to cure your breach by no later than **March 4, 2005**, we will be required to revoke your .us accreditation and begin the process of transferring all of your existing customers of .us domain names to another .us accredited registrar.

We would also like to remind you that you will have until **January 26, 2006** to phase out all of your existing customers using this service and to update their contact records with the registry to reflect the true Registrant, Administrative, Billing and Technical contacts.
